


HD Video Conferencing Terminal

Quick Start

Remote Controller




Note:

- The remote controller's effective working distance is 10 meters.
- The performance of the remote controller may be influenced by strong light.



Function Introduction

Press  button on the remote controller to access the menu.



1. IP address of the terminal
2. GK/SIP Register Status
3. Rate
4. Protocol Type
5. Recents (call in, call out, unanswered call, call duration)
6. Delete all

When the main menu is displayed, press  button to hide the menu. Use the remote controller's arrow buttons to move selected menu options. Press "OK" to confirm.

Initiate a Conference

1. Press  button to show call menu. If call menu is showed, press  again to initiate a conference call.
2. Input conference room number or IP address in the address box.
3. Select call types and protocol rates.
4. You can press  on the remote controller to initiate a call. Alternatively, you can select the "Call" option on the menu and press **OK** to initiate a call.

On-screen keyboard

Press **OK** button when the cursor is in the input box. The user can input CN/EN characters and symbols through the on-screen keyboard.



Switch On/Off Local Microphone

Press the  button to switch on/off the local microphone.

 Note:

- Press the power button on the microphone and the light indicator always shows red.
- During operation, make sure the microphone is powered on (light indicator is on).



Volume Adjustment

Press  button to adjust the sound volume. The local speaker will be turned off if the volume is adjusted to the minimum.



Camera Selection and Control

Before a conference, if the menu is hidden, the user can control the local cameras. During a conference, if remote camera control is permitted, you can control these cameras remotely.

Switch local/remote cameras	Press  button to switch local/remote cameras.
Camera Control	Press arrow buttons to rotate the camera. Press  button to zoom in or out.



Switch Display Mode

Press  button to switch display mode on the screen.



Send or Stop Double Stream

Connect a set of PC or other external device to the DVI-I IN of the terminal by using a DVI cable as a secondary video input. Press  button to send the secondary video to other conferencing terminals. Press  again to stop sending secondary video.

If you don't have a DVI cable, please contact your terminal administrator for help.



End Conference

Press  button to end the conference.
